Authorisation Directive Simplification

- Directive 2002/20/EC on the authorisation of electronic communications networks and services
- Harmonisation and simplification of authorisation rules and conditions
- Objective to create a legal framework to ensure the freedom to provide networks and services





From individual license to general authorisation

- All electronic communications services and networks covered by a general authorisation
- General authorisation legal framework ensuring rights for the provision of services
- Notification procedure only no explicit decision or administrative act
- Declaration of rights upon request





Conditions attached to the general authorisation

- Article 6 and Annex Part A
- Maximum list of conditions which may be attached
- Sector-specific conditions only
- Must be objectively justified in relation to the network or service; non-discriminatory, proportionate and transparent





Rights of use

- Individual rights of usage only for radio frequencies and numbers
- ... and only where necessary
- Open, transparent and nondiscriminatory procedures
- Numbers 3 weeks; Frequencies 6 weeks





Conditions attached to rights of use

- Article 6 and Annex Part B
- Designation of service or type of network or technology, technical conditions for use
- Efficient use and coverage requirements
- Duration of rights and usage fees
- Must not duplicate conditions of general authorisation





Limiting the number of rights of use

- Analysis and consultation in advance; reviewed periodically or upon request
- Selection criteria that are objective, transparent, non-discriminatory and proportionate
- Article 8 Framework Directive: efficient use and effective management of frequency resources
- Competitive or comparative selection procedures: maximum 8 months





Limiting the burden on operators

- Charges limited to real administrative costs, transparent and proportionate; annual review / adjustments
- Ex-ante information required by NRAs limited to minimum; ex-post information limited to specific purposes
- Proportionate penalties for noncompliance with conditions, withdrawal / suspension of the right to provide a service in exceptional cases only





Authorisation Directive Areas for improvement

- Simplification of national regimes to facilitate cross-border and pan-European service provision
- Common approach to the allocation/ assignment of radio frequencies at European level
- New Member States: adaptation of existing authorisations and eliminating discimination between "old" and "new" entrants
