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# Trade in live animals

- Only live animals that fulfil the EU requirements to be sent to Member States
- Separation of animals of different health status during transport from origin to destination
- Procedures for health certificates
- Assembly centres, transporters, dealers

# Animal health conditions

– Other animals, semen, ova and embryos	92/65/EEC
