LEGISLATIVE FRAMEWORK (CONT'D)

By-law on Dangerous Chemicals aims

to arrange the administrative and technical procedures relating to the protection of human health and environment from the negative effects of dangerous chemicals by controlling them

LEGISLATIVE FRAMEWORK (CONT'D)

By-law on DC transposes the Directive

- Article 4: Definitions (except notification and notifier and
- **EINECS**)
- Articles 12 and 22: Safety Data Sheet
- Annex IV: Symbols and indication of danger
- Annex VII: Nature of special risk attaching to dangerous substances
- Annex VII: Safety advice concerning dangerous chemical

LEGISLATIVE FRAMEWORK (CONT'D)

By-law on DC partially transposes the Directive

- Article 1: Objectives and scope
- Articles 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27: Packaging
- Articles 16, 17, 18 and 20: Labelling
- Articles 16, 17, 18 and 20: Implementation of labelling

requirements

- Articles 16,17, 18 and 20: Exemption from labelling requirements
- Annex I: List of dangerous substances





LEGISLATIVE FRAMEWORK (CONT'D)

Communiqué on the Procedure for Filling of the Safety Data Sheets

Aims

to arrange the procedure and the format of filling and, to determine the information which shall be present in the sheets

Transposes

Article 3 and the Annex of Directive on Safety Data Sheets (91/155/EEC) with its all revisions/amendments
